## Podcast OURGENPOD Nominated for Discover Pods Award

Monday, January 6, 2025 – Los Angeles, CA – www.OURGENPOD.com, the podcast by, for and about listeners 55+, has been nominated for the Discover Pods Award in the Society and Culture Category. The final round of voting is open to the public and closes on January 10<sup>th</sup>.

The podcast has also run a series on "Ageism" with expert Ashton Applewhite, PBS Next Avenue's Influencer of the Year and author of "This Chair Rocks: A Manifesto Against Ageism."
